Must complete 6 hours of training under the supervision of a certified livestock volunteer.		
Giving a 3-5 minute presentation at Ky. State Fair in August. If presentations are under 3 minutes or over 5 minutes they receive 2 point deduction off the average score. Please see special note regarding Seniors. On the required topic: <u>Junior (Born 2006 - 2002)</u> How to cook and store a country ham - Discuss the best ways to store your country ham after the fair and the various ways to cook a country ham. <u>Senior (Born 1997 - 2001)</u> Insects that infest country hams and how to control them – Discuss the insects that commonly infest country and the USDA/FDA approved methods used to control insects. Please note – ALL SENIORS PRESENTATIONS MUST BE AT LEAST 2 MINUTES LONG OR THEY WILL BE DIS-QUALIFIED AND HAMS FORFIETED.		
Pay \$60.00 fee – you will receive 2 hams (failure to complete the project, fee will NOT be refunded and you will forfeit both hams, Upon forfeit, if the two hams are not returned an additional \$60.00 fee will be charged and if the additional fee is not paid the 4-H member will not be able to participate in next years' country ham project).		

All winning hams will be placed on display at the Kentucky State Fair and will be returned at its conclusion.
